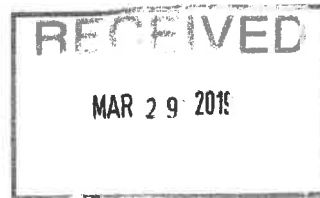


Mayor and Council,
