
Bylaw No. 08-2010

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND GOVERN THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS
AND EXPLOSIVES IN THE TOWN OF WADENA**

The Council of the Town of Wadena in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall fire or discharge any air or pellet gun, use any class of guns, firearms or other devices that are designated for or capable of discharging projectiles of any type within the limits of the Town of Wadena except as provided elsewhere in this bylaw or as otherwise approved by the Town of Wadena.
2. For the purpose of pest control only, the Town Council hereby appoints, PRY Investigation and Security Agency bylaw enforcement officers, to discharge a firearm within Town limits.
3. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police shall verify that the appointees are qualified before the appointment is effective. This appointment shall continue until terminated on written notice by the Council of the Town of Wadena or by PRY Investigation and Security Agency
4. Any person found guilty of a breach of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalties Bylaw 15/92 of the Town of Wadena.
5. Bylaw 03-09 is hereby repealed.

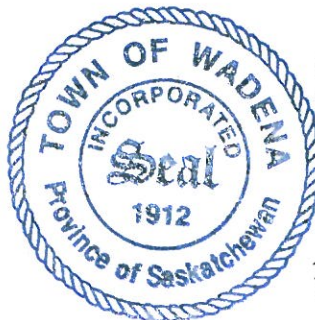





