## WATER MAIN LINE FLUSHING SCHEDULE

Sept 11-12 (North and East)  
Sept 25-26 (West and South)

- Water main flushing will result in discoloration of water due to iron sediment in the area being flushed. However it may cause discoloration in other areas as well.
- No clothes washing should be done during flushing periods as the water may cause discoloration.
- Please be advised to run your cool water tap for a few minutes prior to running hot water.

## TREE BRANCH PICKUP PROGRAM

Sept 27 (West side of town)  
Sept 28 (East side of town)

- Larger than 1/2 ton load is subject to a pickup fee of \$50.00 per 1/2 ton. Less than 1/2 ton load is FREE.
- Branches shall be placed in the same location as garbage pickup by 8AM.
- Branches CANNOT exceed 4 feet in length and 3 inches in diameter.
- DOES NOT INCLUDE pickup of household items, junk or compost.

## What does the Animal Control Bylaw No. 14-18 say?

- Every owner of a cat or dog that is over 4 months old shall within 30 days of becoming the owner obtain a license for each cat or dog.
- Pet Licenses expire **December 31st** and shall be renewed prior to its expiration.
- Failure to license your cat or dog has a corresponding fine: \$250 (1st Offence), \$300 (2nd Offence), \$350 (Subsequent)

### ANNUAL LICENSE FEES

- \$20** - Cat or Dog under 12 months old
- \$60** - Not microchipped, not spayed or neutered
- \$35** - Microchipped, but not spayed or neutered
- \$15** - Not microchipped but is spayed or neutered
