Bylaw No. 1-97 says that:

OWNERS or OCCUPANTS shall remove snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions from sidewalks adjoining premises owned or occupied by them.

If, after 48 hours owners or occupants neglect to clear their sidewalks, Council is empowered to provide for the removal of snow, ice, dirt and other obstructions.

NO OWNER OR OCCUPANT shall cause snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction to be cleared and/or removed from their property onto the sidewalk, boulevard, street, lane and other property owned or controlled by the Town of Wadena.

In violation thereof, the Council through resolution can remove the snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction. The cost of removal which is a minimum of \$75.00 per occurrence, if not paid by the owner or occupant shall be applied to the taxes of the property.

*** Non-salt ice melt of approved type that will not damage the sidewalks is available at the Town Office.

Running Water / Drip Lines

Turning on and off of drip lines or running water requires the account holder to be present and sign a waiver in a form prescribed by the Town.

From the time that the drip line or running water has been turned on until it is turned off the account will be billed the minimum billing or the average usage whichever is more. Average usage will be based on the previous two billing periods.

Drip lines / running water are turned on and off at the discretion of the Town and such work may be performed only by a Public Works Employee. Account holders may be liable for actual usage if they turn their own drip lines or running water on.
